It is well known that the Manchester Rosh Yeshiva, Yehuda Zev Segal זצ"ל, Bentzion Aba Shaul זצ"ל and Rav Zundel Kroizer זצ"ל, all began their learning sedarim by speaking out their kavanah to fulfill the mitzvah of תלמוד תורה.

In addition, Hagaon Rav Gamliel Rabinovich shlit"a said that HaGaon Hatzadik R' Zundel Kroizer זצ"ל constantly encourage avreichim in kollel to think (and say) before seder,

"לשם מצות תלמוד תורה ולעשות בזה נחת רוח לבורא יתברך שמו".

Hagaon Rav Gamliel Rabinovich also said that his father, Hagaon R' Levi Rabinovitch zt"l, constantly encourage people, especially bar mitzvah boys to be מכוין 'לשם מצוה' as is brought in the Mishnah Berurah: כדי שתהא תורתם לשמה.

Reb Dovid Tzimmerman, a close talmid of HaRay HaGaon R' Shach ז"צל, recalled that one day as R' Shach left his home to go give shiur in Ponevezh Yeshiva, he heard him whisper to himself:

"הנני מוכן ומזומן לקיים מצות "ושננתם לבניך.

The Brisker Rav once told his talmid Rav Refoel Reichman shlit"a, that the din of mitzvos tzrichos kavana applies to the mitzvah of Talmud Torah, however, if one was not mechaven, he still has the Torah that he learned.

If one is learning with his son, he can also have Kavanah to ולמדתם אתם את Ifill the mitzvah of ולמדתם בניכם. (Another good time for this Ravanah is when reviewing their פרשה sheets on שבת.) Before doing so, remember to say,

that when we say the words איני מור בינים וויים אינים מור אינים

perfect — the ones that were done with proper kavanah! It is well worth thinking about this while we can still do something about it!
